
Mendel University in Brno

- Established in 1919
- The oldest independent University of its kind in the Czech Republic
- Named after Gregor Johann MENDEL (1822-1884)
 the botanist and founder of modern genetics who lived and did his research in Brno

- Grounds for practical demonstration, training and research
- Experimental forest stands, greenhouses, forest nurseries, game preserve, a saw mill, mechanised log depot, and other establishments for educational and research purposes
- Since 1997, **holder of the FSC Certificate** for Forestry
- Over 10,000 hectares of forestland
- About a third of the TFE area situated within the Protected Landscape Area of the Moravian Karst

Botanical Garden and Arboretum
